

# CREATING FIGURED BASS WITH STAFFWRITER:

To type figured bass using StaffWriter font,

- 1) Type the Roman Numeral, (*for P.C., use 1 StaffWr.txt font*) then,
- 2) Type a "time signature" that matches the inversion you want, (*P.C., use 1 StaffWr.sym font*) following the instructions listed under "Creating Time Signatures", then,
- 3) "Superscript" the numbers! Cool, huh?

Step 1 & 2. Type: V then 5<sup>6</sup> (i.e.: V<sup>6</sup><sub>5</sub>)

Step 3. Highlight the 5 and click "superscript" to get: V<sup>6</sup><sub>5</sub>

Examples: I<sup>6</sup><sub>3</sub> V<sup>6</sup><sub>5</sub> V<sup>4</sup><sub>3</sub> V<sup>4</sup><sub>2</sub> I<sup>6</sup><sub>4</sub>

Even type: V<sup>6</sup><sub>sus4</sub> or, V<sup>6</sup><sub>sus4-3</sub> or, V<sup>9</sup><sub>no 5</sub>

"Top" numbers that are possible: 2 3 4 5 6 9 12

Any bottom number is O.K. (*They're from the text's number row.*)

NOTE: Complex inversions can be made by writing the numbers in "text boxes", superscript them, and move the two numbers over each other. (w/no line/no fill & wrap "in front of text")

I 11 #7 becomes I<sup>11</sup><sub>#7</sub>
